Activity 12 of the two-year work plan: Promotion of the LCIPP at the national and regional level

Decision 2/CP.23 paragraph 8 recommended that the processes under the LCIPP, including its operationalization, take into account, inter alia, the interests and views of local communities and indigenous peoples as well as the following principles proposed by indigenous peoples organizations: full and effective participation of indigenous peoples; equal status of indigenous peoples and Parties, including in leadership roles; self-selection of representatives of indigenous peoples in accordance with their own procedures; and adequate funding from the secretariat and voluntary contributions to enable the functions of the Platform.

3 FUNCTIONS OF THE LCIPP

KNOWLEDGE

Promoting the exchange of experience and best practices of traditional knowledge, technologies, practices and efforts of local communities and indigenous peoples in addressing and responding to climate change



CAPACITY FOR ENGAGEMENT

Building the capacity of local communities and indigenous peoples to enable their engagement in the UNFCCC and other related processes as well as the capacity of Parties and other relevant stakeholders to engage with the Platform and local communities and indigenous peoples

CLIMATE POLICIES AND ACTIONS

Facilitating the integration of diverse knowledge systems, practices and innovations in designing and implementing actions, programmes and policies, as well as facilitating the undertaking of stronger and more ambitious climate action by local communities and indigenous peoples

The COP has emphasised in its entirety the UNDRIP in the context of the implementation of the functions of the LCIPP involving indigenous peoples

FACILITATIVE WORKING GROUP (FWG)



- Constituted body that facilitates the implementation of the 3 functions of the LCIPP
- 14 members: 7 representatives of indigenous peoples organisations, 7 Party representatives
- Representation of the 7 UN indigenous sociocultural regions

ACTIVITIES PERFORMED BY THE LCIPP

- Activities of the LCIPP work plan
- FWG meetings twice a year
- Engagement with bodies and processes across the UNFCCC
- Collaboration with relevant bodies outside the UNFCCC
