Facilitative Working Group Retreat

SUMMARY OF RETREAT ACTION POINTS LCIPP

The Facilitative Working Group (FWG) of the Local Communities and Indigenous Peoples Platform (LCIPP) held an intersessional retreat from 24 to 26 January 2023. This document summarizes action points agreed upon during the retreat, which will be reviewed and considered by the FWG during its 9th meeting.

Summary of FWG action points

- 1) Consider adopting its draft working modalities for operational purposes, understanding that overall, the draft rules of procedure of the COP and its Subsidiary Bodies, shall apply to the FWG.
- 2) Review and adopt its vision statement.
- 3) In line with the workplan, conduct **capacity-building sessions for knowledge holders** nominated to participate in the LCIPP-mandated events at the session of the COP and facilitate their informed participation in the UNFCCC process.
- 4) Raise awareness and facilitate **enhanced contributions** from Indigenous Peoples and local communities **to the UNFCCC submissions portal** for
 - a. Various calls for submission under LCIPP and across the UNFCCC process
 - b. Inputs for the FWG review in 2024
 - c. Inputs for the third three-year work plan of LCIPP.
- 5) **Enhance Party engagement** in various LCIPP activities through the FWG Party members and by way of notifications.
- 6) Encourage activity focal points to take the lead in **facilitating more intentional and inter-** body collaboration with other Constituted Bodies.
- 7) Update **Activity Concept notes** to facilitate inter-sessional work and enhance meaningful engagement with relevant workstreams and constituted bodies under the UNFCCC.
