

# Regional Collaboration Centres - regional presence





- Established in 2015 by UNFCCC & Institute for Global Environmental Strategies (IGES)



# REGIONAL COLLABORATION (LCIPP LENS)



- UNFCCC regional presence/global reach (timezone issue etc)
- Knowledge and resource base: Source know-how and resources on different elements of the Paris Agreement
- Matchmaking: Uniquely positioned to form strategic engagements and partnerships with regional entities and broker support to local communities and Indigenous Peoples through scanning of needs and available support
- Coordination and collaboration hub: Pacific is rich with Indigenous values and practices and also severely impacted by climate change need to find ways for effective collaboration i.e. facilitating regional exchange crisscrossing topics beneficial to local communities and Indigenous Peoples
- Capacity building for local communities and Indigenous Peoples
