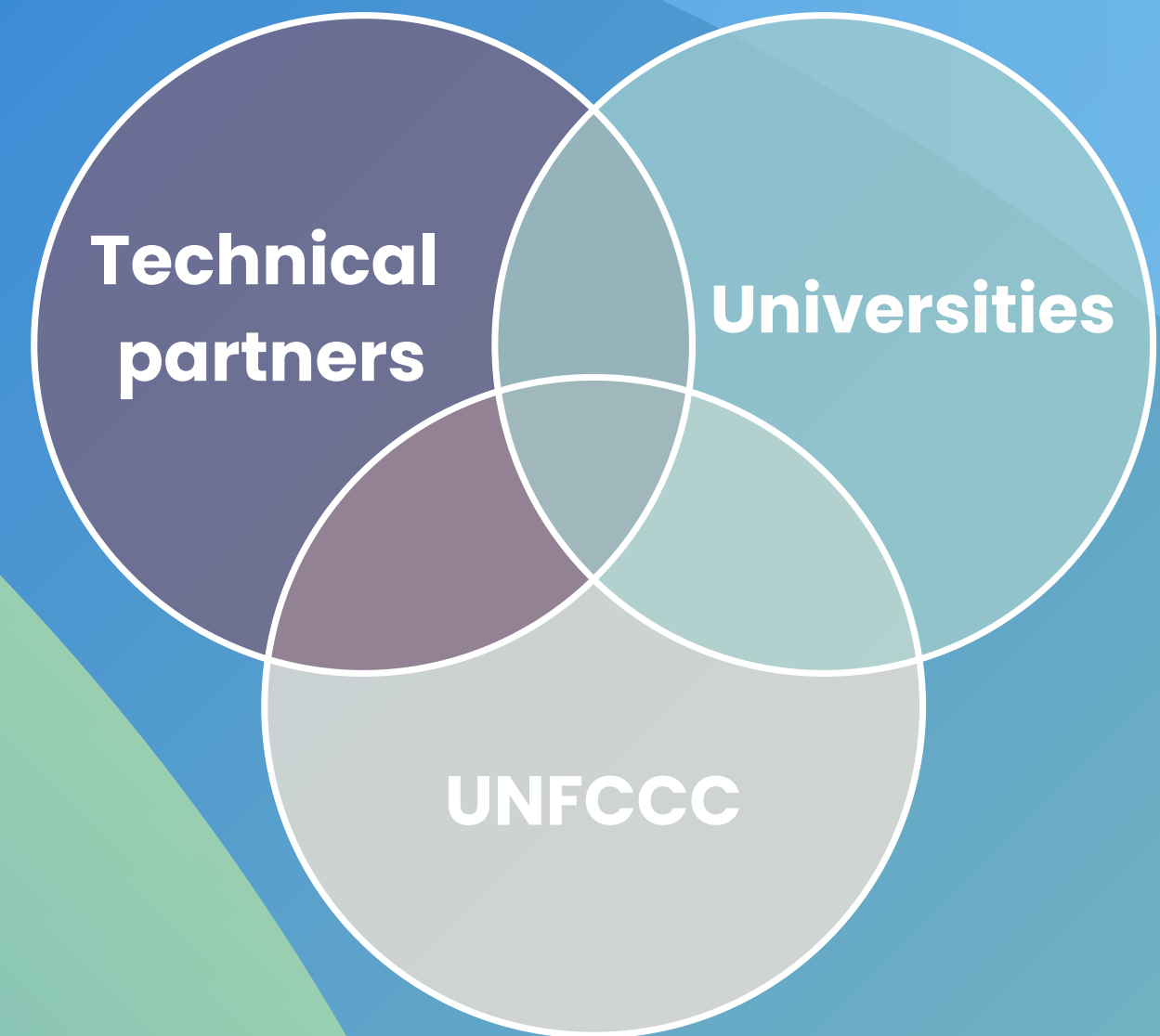


# How can educational systems focusing on climate action effectively integrate important insights from Indigenous curricula and resources?

Develop brief concepts and disseminate widely

## 03 ENGAGEMENT, ACTION AND LEARNING

Initiate partnerships between the university and partner/s (e.g. develop TORs) and execute the project keeping knowledge users in mind

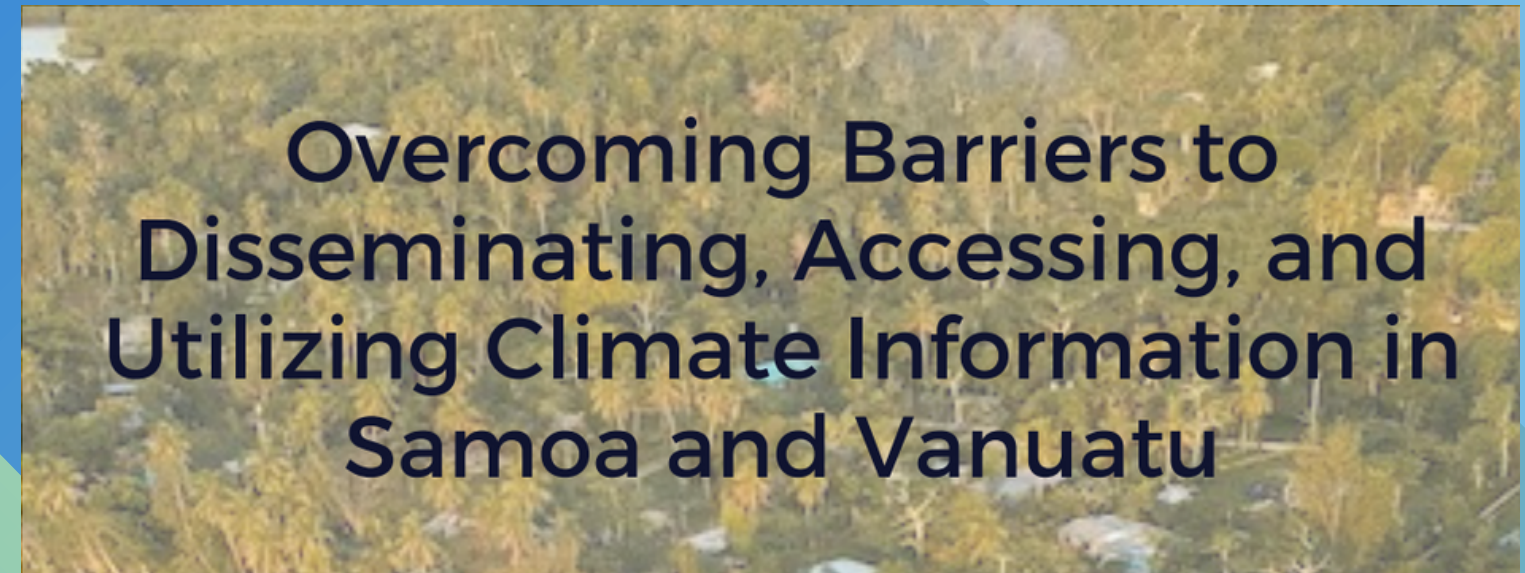


## 05 REFINE THE ENGAGEMENT MODEL


Refine the engagement model based on long term impacts and progress
