The incoming COP 30 Presidency has also established the Circle of the Peoples to broaden the participation of stakeholders in the climate regime. It is composed of:

- the International Indigenous Commission;
- the International Commission of Traditional Communities, People of African Descent and Family Farmers.

The International Commission of Traditional Communities, People of African Descent and Family Farmers (launched in Brasilia, Brazil on 29 May 2025) held its first meeting on 18 June in Bonn, Germany. The second meeting is scheduled for 2 September in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia. Four virtual thematic workshops are also being planned, the first of which will take place on 8 August.
