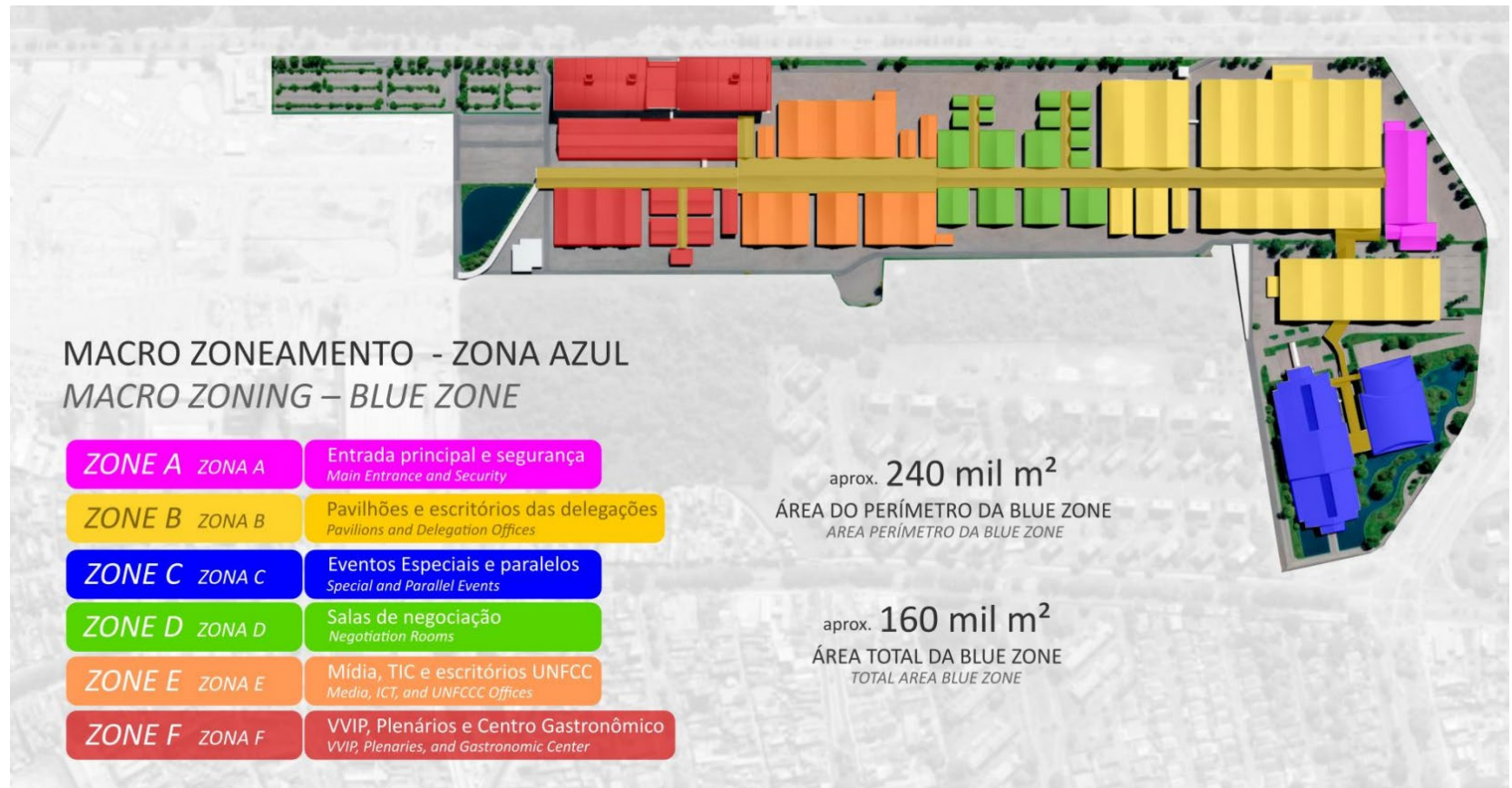

Registration

Managed through the UNFCCC **Online Registration System (ORS)**

Info and registration: <https://unfccc.int/cop30/observer-organizations>

- **Parties and Observer States, UN organizations, and specialized agencies:**
Nomination and confirmation by 9 November 23:59 (CET)
- **Admitted intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations:**
Nomination by 17 August 23:59 (CEST), confirmation by 9 November 23:59 (CET)

Required Documents

- Acknowledgement letter from ORS (printed or mobile device)
- Valid passport or nationally approved photo ID

No fees for participation; third-party sale of badges is prohibited

- **Information for Participants** published

Application Process

- Upload your **UNFCCC acknowledgement letter** with your e-Visa application.
- Processing time: **up to 10 working days** after submission of a complete application.
- Status updates will be sent to the **email address** used in the application.

Check visa requirements
for your nationality

If a visa is required:

- Apply via **the COP 30 e-Visa Application Portal**
- Start the process **as early as possible** to avoid delays

Free for all COP 30 participants

Planned Services:

-  **Bike-sharing near the venue**

Safety & Security

- **UNDSS 3rd technical mission** in early August confirmed **foundational planning is in place** → a solid base for upcoming operations

Health & Medical Support

- Delegates have **free access to Brazil's Unified Health System (SUS)** for emergencies;
- **Integrated Health Operations Control Center** will be run by the Ministry of Health for medical services.

Recommended Vaccines

Yellow fever, Measles
