The Ishpata discovery survey conducted by the I.N.N Pakistan team in September 2022 in Kalasha Valley is a comprehensive study that provides valuable insights into the current situation of the Kalasha people residing in the region.

The survey found that there are currently 3,980 Kalasha individuals living in the valley, with 1,873 females and 2,107 males. Interestingly, the survey also observed that there were 237 fewer females than males in the community.

The survey also revealed that since 2012, more than 150 individuals have changed their faith. Additionally, the survey found that there were 1,721 individuals below the age of 18, while 2,259 were adults. The survey also identified 72 widows in the Kalasha community and 47 individuals with special needs.

In terms of education, the survey found that there were 1,187 students studying in primary schools, while 601 students were studying at high schools, colleges, and universities. The survey also noted that only 392 individuals were employed in government and private sectors.

Overall, the Ishpata discovery survey provides important demographic, educational, and employment-related data about the Kalasha community in the valley. The survey's findings can be used to inform policies and programs aimed at improving the lives of the Kalasha people and promoting their cultural heritage.
